

Barry Pearce Peace Memorial Lecture



The Barry Pearce Peace Memorial Lecture has been established by the Creative Ministries Network Board to remember, honour and contribute to Barry's legacy to Veterans Faith and Wellbeing Support, to the CMN Board and to the wider veterans' community and their families.

It is intended the lecture will be part of the CMN's Annual Remembrance Eve Dinner.

The Board has established a **Trust Fund** to provide an honorarium for speakers for the lecture.

The Board intends to appoint trustees to:

- Administer the fund.
- Nominate the annual lecturer to the Board.
- Assist in raising funds for the Trust to maintain the lecture.

Of the trustees, it is intended that at least two will be appointed by Barry's family, and two will be appointed by the Board. A Board appointed member of the Trust will convene the trustees, be the executive officer for the Trust, and ensure the reporting relationship to the Board.

The proposed aims of the Barry Pearce Peace Memorial Lecture are:

- ❖ To remember Barry Pearce as a faithful disciple of Jesus Christ, who strived to live out his faith in every aspect of his life.
- ❖ To draw upon Christian teaching and contemporary knowledge to reflect on the impact of military training and war service on participants, their families and nations, both friends and enemies.
- ❖ To encourage the testimony of those healed of the wounds of war through deepening their faith and spiritual awareness, and the practice of spiritual disciplines.
- ❖ To contribute to the development of world peace by resisting the evil and violence of war through nurturing trust in God and 'putting on the whole armour of God' (Eph.6:11).
